My Story

Katie was born July 8, 1914 and raised in Harrison County, Indiana. Her family moved to Knox County in 1931, where Katie graduated with the class of 1932 from Oaktown High School.

Katie's family lived about a mile from Emison where they attended Emison Methodist Church. This is where Katie met and married her husband, Cecil Dunkerly.

Katie served as treasurer of Emison Church and when she and Cecil moved to Oaktown she became treasurer of their church. She held this office for 20 years. Katie was very active in her community and served on the Oaktown Cemetery Board and the Oaktown Busseron Township High School Alumni Association.

Katie was the first woman to ever work at the Oaktown Security Bank. In 1979 she retired as Assistant Branch Manager having worked there for 36 years.

Katie joined Eastern Star in 1944. She received the Award of Gold for 50 years service.

Katie has been recognized many times for her community service. In 1983 Oaktown named her *Woman of the Year* and in 1984, Governor Orr named her *Sagamore of the Wabash*.

Katie loved to quilt and work in her garden. Her flowers were a point of interest to anyone driving down old Highway 41.

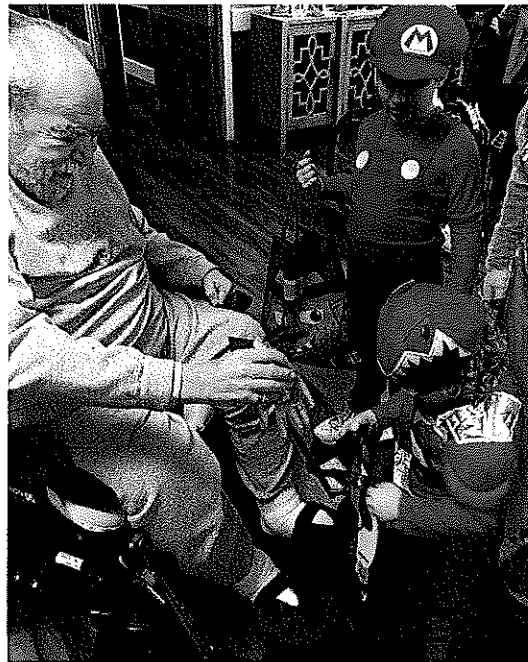

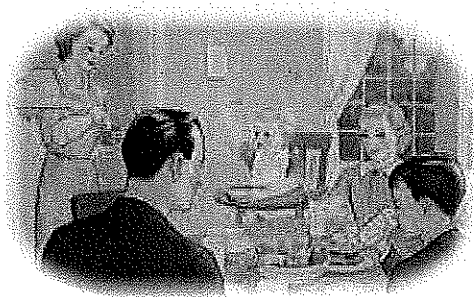
Meet Our Staff
