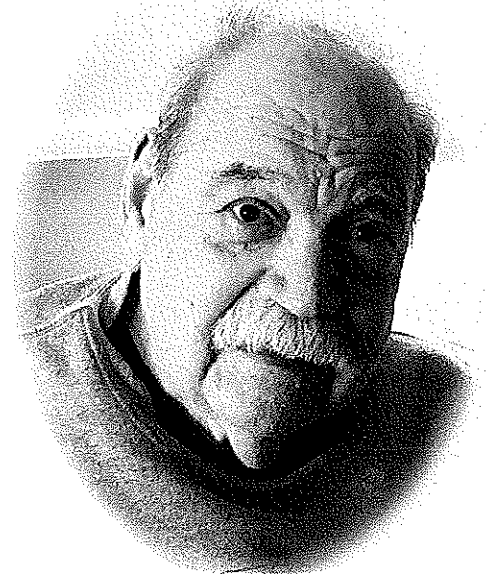

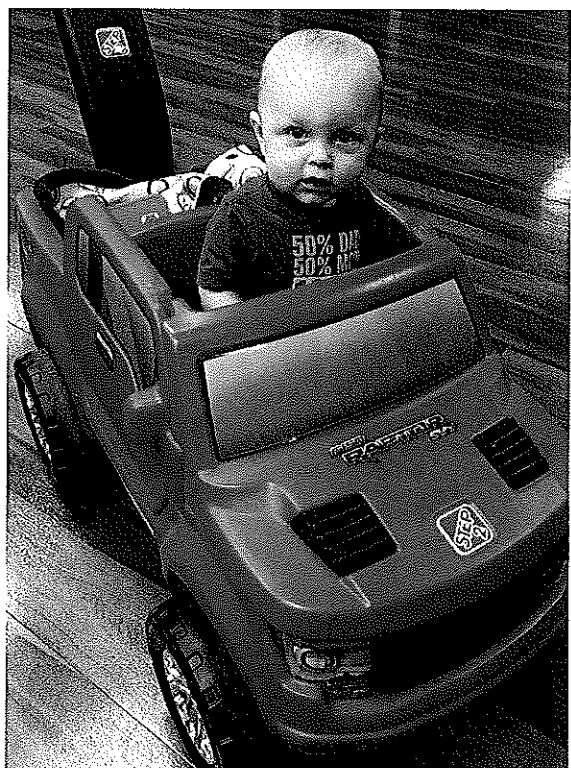
We will have a special celebration and Card Shower for Lena on her birthday, Oct. 21, Friday at 1 pm with musical entertainment.

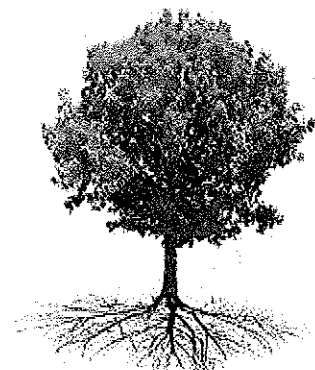

Safe Trick or Treat

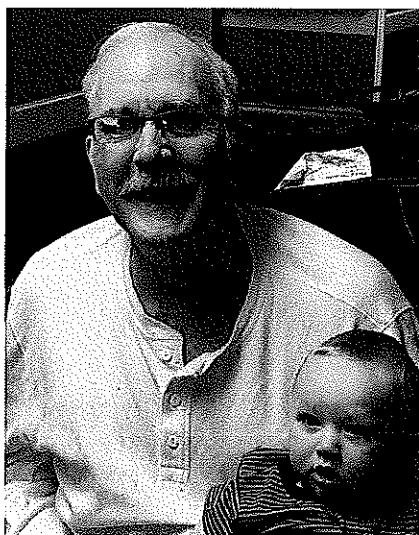

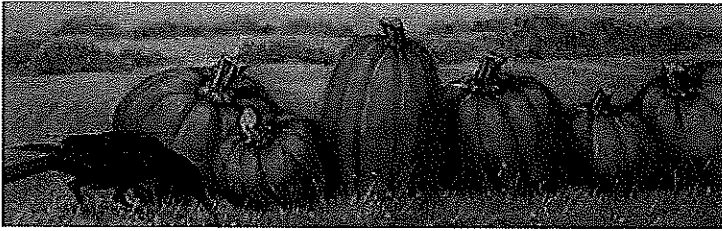
The residents will have their candy ready to pass out for the holiday, please come in costume and trick or treat us.

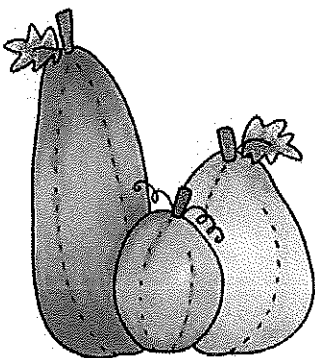
